Enrollment Information

Due to high demand, admission is accepted on a first come basis. We must receive your Student Registration Form and non-refundable registration fee in order to secure your student's place in the appropriate class for the 2018-2019 school year. Once a class is filled, we will begin a wait list.

Tuition and Fees

A non-refundable registration fee of \$40 is required to secure your enrollment in the program. After May 1st, the non-refundable registration fee is \$50. Tuition is due on the 1st of each month and considered late by the 10th.

Preschool Classes Offered

3 year old Class Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday 9:15-11:45 A.M.

*Child must be 3 years old by August 31, 2018 and able to perform all toileting needs independently (potty trained for at least 3 months prior) to qualify for this class.

TEACHER: Mrs. Hagglund

- **The 3 year old class** focuses on identifying and counting numbers 1-10, recognizing letters, identifying colors and shapes, learning days of the week, months of the year and more.

4 year old Class Monday, Wednesday and Friday 9-11:30AM or 12:30-3 PM

*Child must be 4 years old by August 31, 2018 to qualify for these classes.

TEACHER: Mrs. McCall

- **The 4 year old class** focuses on phonetic sounds, identifying and tracing upper/lowercase letters, pattern recognition, sorting, writing name/phone number, counting to 100 and more.

5 year old Class Tuesday and Thursday 9 AM – 12:30 PM

*Child must be 5 years old by December 31, 2018 to qualify for this class.

TEACHER: Mrs. Williams

- **The 5 year old class** focuses on memorizing phonetic sounds, beginning science concepts, sorting, sequencing, opposites, rhyming, using pencils, scissors and other equipment correctly.

Our Daily Schedule

Each class provides a structured learning environment that includes these basic activities.

<u>Welcome Time:</u>	Children are greeted individually as they enter the classroom.
<u>Free Choice Time:</u>	Children can choose from various educational areas, including books, pretend play, puzzles, blocks, art, vehicle play and others.
<u>Circle Time:</u>	Children participate in singing, weather, calendar, themes, and guided conversation.
<u>Learning Time:</u>	Children will receive instruction and practice learning new concepts.
<u>Snack Time:</u>	Children will take turns providing a snack and drink.
<u>Recess Time:</u>	Children will exercise and play games outside on the playground or inside in our Fellowship room, depending upon the weather.
<u>Story Time:</u>	Children will listen and participate interactively to stories.
<u>Goodbye Time:</u>	Children will sing a goodbye song to wrap up the day.
