You can use your car radio – or a portable radio with batteries. When you arrive, you will be offered a sealed Communion set so that when we celebrate Holy Communion, you will already have it in your car. If you do not want it, just wave them off. Our attendants will be gloved and masked. The entire service will be conducted from the platform. Please turn off your vehicle during the service. Remember to back into the parking stalls in the main church parking lot. This will be a fun adventure. We will learn together as we go!!

**Everyone must remain inside their vehicles at all times while at church.**

We will continue to provide both "Drive In" worship and "Online" worship, each Sunday until we have access to our church building.

On another note:

You might have noticed people around town seeking signatures for Referendum 90. It is a referendum to repeal the new K-12 Sex Ed Law. The state legislature passed Bill 5395 concerning comprehensive sexual health education. The bill will require school districts to adopt or develop comprehensive age-appropriate sexual health education consistent with state standards. **The bill was passed without public involvement.** This referendum seeks to have this bill approved by the people of the state during the November 3<sup>rd</sup> election.

I encourage you to examine both the bill and the referendum at [Parentsforsafeschools.com](http://Parentsforsafeschools.com). This bill, if passed, can have long lasting effects upon schools, educators, and students mandating that sex education be taught based upon state approved standards.
