#### Enrollment Information

All Registration will be done online through the Brightwheel app/Website. There will be NO in-person registration.

Links to the registration system will be posted on our website on the following days/times as they go live. Due to high demand, admission is accepted on a first come basis.

**Current Families/Church Members:** Monday, February 20, 8am

**Previous Families:** Wednesday, February 22, 8am

**New Families:** Friday, February 24, 7am

You will receive a notification within a day of registration, letting you know what class your child has been placed in, or if you are on a waitlist. An invoice for registration fees will be sent to all students placed on a class roster. This fee must be paid within 12 hours to hold your spot in the class.

#### Tuition and Fees

A non-refundable registration fee of \$75 is required to secure your enrollment in the program.

Tuition is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month and considered late by the 10<sup>th</sup>, which will incur a late fee.

#### Preschool Classes Offered

**3 year old Class** (TEACHER: Mrs. Rockwood)

**Monday/Thursday -or- Tuesday/Friday**

**9:15-11:45 A.M.**

**3 year old Class** (TEACHER: Mrs. Breum)

**Tuesday/Thursday** (upstairs classroom)

**9:00-11:30 A.M.**

\*Child must be 3 years old by August 31, 2023 and able to perform all toileting needs independently (potty trained for at least 3 months prior) to qualify for this class.

- **The 3 year old class** focuses on identifying and counting numbers 1-10, recognizing letters and name, identifying colors and shapes, learning days of the week, months of the year and more.

**4 year old Class** (TEACHER: Mrs. McCall)

**Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 8:45-11:30AM or 12:15-3:00 PM**

\*Child must be 4 years old by August 31, 2023 to qualify for these classes.

- **The 4 year old class** focuses on phonetic sounds, identifying and tracing upper/lowercase letters, pattern recognition, beginning science concepts, sorting, writing name, strengthening fine motor skills, counting to 20+ and much more.

**4/5 year old Class** (TEACHER: Mrs. Breum)

**Monday, Wednesday, every other Friday 9 AM – 1:00 PM**

\*Child must be 5 years old by February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to qualify for these classes.

- **The 5 year old class** focuses on memorizing phonetic sounds, writing, science concepts, sorting, sequencing, patterns, rhyming, using pencils, scissors and other equipment correctly.

## **Our Daily Schedule**

Each class provides a structured learning environment that includes these basic activities throughout their day:

<b><u>Welcome Time:</u></b>	Children are greeted individually as they enter the classroom, with an activity waiting for them at their seat.
<b><u>Center/Rotation Time:</u></b>	Children can choose from various educational areas, including books, pretend play, puzzles, blocks, art, science, writing, vehicle play and others.
<b><u>Circle Time:</u></b>	Children participate in singing, weather, calendar, themes, and guided conversation.
<b><u>Learning Time:</u></b>	Children will receive instruction and practice learning new concepts.
<b><u>Snack Time/</u></b>	Children will take turns providing a snack and drink.
<b><u>Lunch (4/5yr class):</u></b>	Children will bring their own lunch to class each day.
<b><u>Recess Time:</u></b>	Children will exercise and play games outside on the playground or inside in our Fellowship room, depending upon the weather.
<b><u>Story Time:</u></b>	Children will listen and participate interactively to stories.
<b><u>Goodbye Time:</u></b>	Children will sing a goodbye song to wrap up the day.
